

Final regulations published in the Federal Register on October 29, 2010, [75 FR66665 and FR 66832], by the U.S. Department of Education require institutions that participate in the student financial assistance programs authorized under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended (the HEA), to report certain information about students who enrolled in Title IV-eligible education programs that lead to gainful employment in a recognized occupations (GE Programs)
